SBI Clerk 2023 Exam Pattern

The selection process for the SBI clerk comprises two online examinations: the Preliminary examination followed by the Mains examination. Subsequently, there's a test to assess proficiency in the specified local language. To qualify for the last round, you'll need to submit a 10th or 12th standard mark sheet or certificate demonstrating your study of the chosen local language.

The preliminary round entails 100 objective-type questions distributed across three sections. SBI Clerk Main Examination 2023

SBI Clerk 2023 Important Dates

Keeping a track of important dates is vital for candidates intending to apply for the SBI Clerk 2023 examination. From the start of the application process to the day of the exam, candidates should note these dates to avoid missing any critical deadlines. As per last year's notice, the State Bank of India will now penalize candidates for wrong answers in the objective type tests. Moreover, the marking scheme differs between the Preliminary and Mains exams, except for the negative marking policy.

- In the preliminary exam, there are 100 questions, each carrying 1 mark.
- In the main exam, General/Financial Awareness, English Language, and Quantitative Aptitude have questions worth 1 mark each, while Reasoning Ability and Computer Aptitude together include 50 questions for 60 marks.
- Additionally, both exams enforce a negative marking system, deducting 1/4 of the allotted mark for each incorrect response.

Let's begin by understanding the essence of marks normalisation. Essentially, it's a statistical approach used to offset any disparities in exam difficulty that might occur between different shifts of the same test. Since various shifts can have varying levels of question complexity, a simple score-to-score comparison might not be equitable. Thus, normalization intervenes to create parity, ensuring a fairer assessment of candidates.

SBI employs the equi-percentitle method for marks normalization in the 2023 SBI clerk examination. The formula used is:

Your percentile rank = {(Total number of students in a slot) - (Your rank in that slot) / (Total number of students in a slot – 1)} x 100.

This formula determines your percentile rank. However, the cutoff depends on the vacancies released by SBI. If your percentile rank surpasses the determined cutoff, you'll qualify for the subsequent round.
